

MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY STUDENT APPLICATION INFORMATION

Application Process

1. All applicants should apply in the Fall of the year preceding entry into the medical technology program. Application packets may be obtained by contacting the program director at one of the hospitals listed below or from your university medical technology advisor.
2. The deadline for applications is October 15th, as established by the Oklahoma Consortium of Clinical Laboratory Science Affiliates (OCCLSA). Application(s) should be sent **Attn: School of Medical Technology** to the hospital(s) listed:

Comanche County Memorial Hospital	Lawton, Oklahoma
Muskogee Regional Medical Center	Muskogee, Oklahoma
Saint Francis Hospital	Tulsa, Oklahoma
Valley View Regional Hospital	Ada, Oklahoma

Note: If a student is applying to one or more hospitals, he/she must submit an application to each hospital.

3. Applications received on or before October 15th will be considered for the following summer MT program. Any application received after this date will be accepted, but will only be considered if a hospital program has a vacancy after the matching process (see below). If the matching process results in no vacancies, late applications will be held for the next application period.

Interview Process

1. Interviews will be held during the months of October through January 15th for the summer class. **Contact the hospital(s) for specific interview dates and times.**
2. At the completion of the interview, the applicant will be given a matching form. The purpose of this form is to allow the applicant an opportunity to rank each hospital in order of preference. Note: If a student is interviewing at more than one hospital, he/she only needs to submit one matching form.

Matching Process

The Oklahoma Consortium of Laboratory Science Affiliates (OCCLSA) supports a matching program for placing their applicants. It is similar to the system used by the National Intern and Resident Matching Program for medical students.

The OCCLSA Matching Committee will meet the last Friday in January. The hospital and student lists will be matched at that time. Letters containing matching forms will be opened **only** on the day of matching. The student will be placed at his/her most preferred hospital which has listed that student on their acceptance list. **In this system, the student is given priority.**
